As of March 12, 2020 the U.S. Government has ordered visitor restrictions for all senior communities.

The Government has mandated Essential Visitors Only. Those persons are defined as persons who provide hospice, dementia, or psychosocial support.

All currently-scheduled events at the Danish Home where outside guests attend have been canceled until further notice. This includes Monthly Birthday Party, and our weekly Sunday Sweet Table at 2:00 p.m.

The U.S. has strongly advised that nursing homes for the elderly suspend all medically unnecessary visits. In general, older Americans should avoid non-essential travel in crowded areas.

Currently, there is no defined end to this restriction.

We are sorry for this inconvenience and note this means that family members are prohibited from visiting the residents in our community.

Please understand that this is in the best interest and continued health of our Residents.
